MUST be willing to go through an interview process in order to be offered one of ten Jr. Rec. Leader positions available.

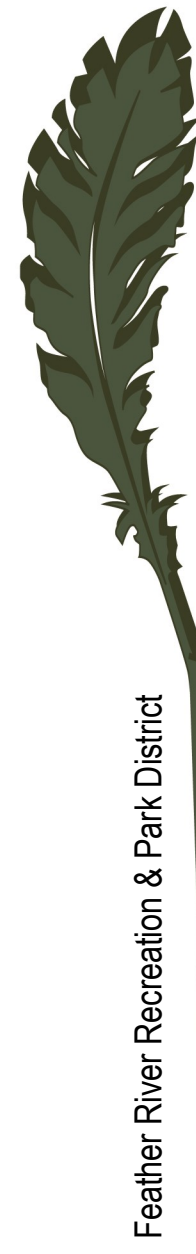

Skills gained:

- How to prepare to become future Feather River Recreation and Park District (FRRPD) Leaders.
- How to organize and lead activities
- Conflict resolution methods
- Proper communication with children ages 5-12
- Proper communication with adults

- Activity facilitation and design

Important:

- ⇒ Junior Recreation Leaders (JRL) and their parents must sign a contract so that both parties understand the responsibilities and expectations of the applicant as a JRL.
- ⇒ JRLs will have evaluations every two weeks to know how they're progressing.

JRL Responsibilities:

- * Attend camp orientation
- * Receive a uniform shirt that MUST be worn when they are working
- * Communicate clearly with the Assistant Director of Children's Services regarding their schedule
- * Work up to 4 hours per day
- * Assigned either an AM shift [8am-12pm] or PM shift [1-5pm]
- * Commit to a minimum of 2 days/week and a maximum of 5 days/week to work
- * Be responsible to pay the JRL camp rate of \$10 per day they work, 2 weeks in advance
- * Bring all questions and concerns to the Assistant Director of Children's Services
- * Be paired up with our experienced Rec. Leaders
- * Be expected to attend the JRL meetings with the Assistant Director of Children's Services as prescheduled
- * Be expected to follow the same employee rules & regulations as Rec. Leaders
