# **Camp Catch a Dream “Summer Session”**

## **Information Sheet**

### **Registration & Payments**

- ⇒ Registration packet is designed to accommodate up to 6 campers. If any camper has special needs or a special diet or allergies please indicate so in the proper area.
- ⇒ Be sure to attach any custody agreements to the packet if you have special circumstance that does not permit a parent/guardian from picking up your camper.
- ⇒ Inform family and friends listed on the pick-up list that they should be prepared to show photo ID each time they come to pick-up your camper.
- ⇒ Return completed registration packet to the FRRPD front desk before the first day of attendance.
- ⇒ Summer Session Camp is to be paid a minimum of two days prior to attending.
- ⇒ Valley Oaks and Cal Works accepted.

### **Late Pick-up**

Camper must be picked up on time, otherwise a will charge of \$20 will be incurred if camper is picked up after 6:05pm. If late pick up becomes consistent camper may be dismissed from program.

### **Meals**

- ⇒ Campers will receive a morning breakfast and lunch from CalKidz. Afternoon snack will be provided by FRRPD.
- ⇒ If you provide your camper(s) with lunch, we request **items that require refrigeration or microwaving are not included.** Please pack an ice pack for camper’s lunch along with a water bottle. Water will be available to refill water bottles.
- ⇒ Be sure to clearly label items camper(s) brings from home so that if it’s left somewhere, camp leaders know who the owner is and may return it.

### **Sign-In/Out Procedure**

- ⇒ Keep staff informed and up to date with who is permitted to pick up your camper.
- ⇒ Ensure that the contacts listed have ACTIVE phone numbers.
- ⇒ It is required that camper is signed in and out everyday.

# **Camp Catch a Dream “Summer Session” Information Sheet (cont.)**

## **Camp Attire**

Campers will be outdoors for the majority of the day, swimming, playing games, and involved in various activities. It is important for camper(s) to have appropriate clothing and shoes. Please send camper(s) with the following LABELED items:

- Backpack
- Athletic or closed toe shoes
- Water Bottle
- Extra pair of clothes
- Lunch (optional)
- Swim shorts or a one piece bathing suit. (Tankinis are okay as long as stomach is covered.)
- Sunblock
- Flip flops **ONLY** for pool time

## **Sunscreen**

Apply sun screen to camper(s) before drop off. Campers should bring waterproof sunblock so that it may be applied before pool time. Please label items. If sunscreen is not provided camper(s) may experience sunburn.

## **Pool Time**

Swim time will be 50 mins, M-F. Be prepared with towel, swim shorts or swim suit (one piece or Tankini is okay as long as stomach is covered). Flip flops are to be worn **ONLY** during pool time, to walk to/from Nelson pool. We will encourage camper(s) to apply sunblock before swim time.

## **Lost & Found**

Be sure to check camper’s belongings daily. Clothes, lunch boxes, water bottles, toys, etc. that do not belong to FRRPD will be placed in Lost & Found box. If items are not claimed by the end of the Summer Camp Session, all Lost & Found items will be donated. This is why it is important to LABEL all campers’ belongings to avoid being lost or misplaced.

# **Camp Catch a Dream “Summer Session” Information Sheet (cont.)**

## **Electronic Toys/Cell Phones**

Camper(s) will be allowed electronic time up to three times a day (morning, after lunch, and the last hour of camp). Camper(s) are not allowed to surf the internet, only play the appropriate games that are on the unit.

First Offense	Verbal warning
Second Offense	Loss of electronic time for day and may be picked up from camp leader upon picking up camper.
Third Offense	Loss of electronic time for 5 days
Fourth Offense	Loss of electronic time for 2 weeks
Five Offense	Complete loss of electronic time for camper

**FRRPD is not responsible for any lost or stolen electronics.**

## **Camp T-Shirt & Field Trips**

Camp shirts will be issued the morning of the first field trip. Camp leaders will write camper's name on the inside collar so that the shirt may be returned to camper if found. 2017 shirts will have the new "Camp Catch a Dream" logo.

- ⇒ **Camp shirt is REQUIRED for attendance of field trips.**
- ⇒ Depending on field trip, additional fees may be required to be paid one day prior to field trip.
- ⇒ Field trips are optional. If you do not wish for your child to attend a field trip, please inform Assistant Director of Children's Services at least a week in advance to ensure prior arrangements are made.



# **Camp Catch a Dream “Summer Camp”**

## **Behavioral Contract**

This contract is to be signed by participants (campers) and parents/guardian. This contract ensures that both camper(s) and adult understand the rules that are enforced and discipline that is ensued when rules are not followed.

### **Rules:**

- ◆ Campers are expected to follow the instructions of FRRPD Staff Rec Leaders at all times.
- ◆ No physical contact between staff members and camper.
- ◆ Items of possession will be handled by owners only unless permission is given by the owner. Stealing or “borrowing” of items without permission is not allowed.
- ◆ Food/beverages will not be shared, with the exception of camper’s siblings.
- ◆ Sunblock may only be shared with siblings. Every camper should bring own sunblock.
- ◆ No name calling or teasing. Only positive dialogue allowed.
- ◆ Participants will be expected to participate in planned activities. If camper is not feeling well, we recommend not bringing your camper to camp, this prevents others from becoming ill. Campers whom are vomiting or have a fever will be sent home.
- ◆ Campers must be dressed appropriately in order to attend camp. Skirts require shorts underneath. No see-through shirts, short shorts, or clothing with inappropriate logos or writing. Clothing and shoes must be worn at all times. Bathing suits must be worn to participate in swim.

After reading the above material, both adult and camper must sign the following page to ensure that all parties understand the rules and discipline that will be enforced at FRRPD’s Camp Catch a Dream Summer Session.

**Contract may be referred to throughout camp if needed.**

- ◆ **Third Offense**           Sent home for day
- ◆ **Fourth Offense**        Sent home for week
- ◆ **Five Offense**           Termination from camp
