RIVERBEND PARK UPDATE



As many questions and concerns begin to surface regarding the flooding of Riverbend Park we thought we would take a moment to pass on the current status.

At this time the park is still experiencing substantial flooding. Most of the site is still under water not allowing District staff to enter the park and assess the damages. We are hopeful in the near future that the waters will recede and we will begin the process of assessment, clean up, repair and replacement of damaged items in the park. Many community members have

requested the opportunity to volunteer their time with cleanup efforts. We appreciate these offers and will be reaching out in the future for this type of assistance. Once the waters recede it will take time for staff to investigate the damages and prepare the documentation necessary to apply for proper funding assistance to get the park back to its original state.
