RIVERBEND PARK UPDATE



Here is another update regarding the status of closing of Riverbend Park.

We understand the huge inconvenience that the closing of

Riverbend Park has placed on our community. Our goal is to assess the damages quickly and begin utilizing other agency resources in our community on smaller projects to reopen the park as soon as possible. Some of this work may begin as soon as next week. Larger projects like the soccer fields, electrical replacement, irrigation and drainage repairs and pavilion repairs will take longer and be subject to insurance reimbursement and FEMA funding options. Once the evacuation order is lifted completely, the river water levels are stable and we are able to assess all dangerous elements in the park we will have a clearer determination of when we may be able to reopen the park. We appreciate your patience as this may take several months and last through the summer.

As an alternative to walking trails, walking your dog, picnicking, etc. we would like to remind you the District owns and maintains multiple other facilities. Some of these include Nelson Complex, MLK Park, and Palermo Park all ideal settings for the aforementioned activities.
