- ◆ MUST complete the JRL registration form
- ◆ MUST go through an interview with supervisor

- ⇒ Show up to camp on the days you signed up for.
- ⇒ Wear uniform shirt when going on field trips.
- ⇒ Commit to a minimum of 2 days per week.
- ⇒ Bring all questions & concerns to your supervisor.
- ⇒ Expected to follow the same employee rules & regulations as campers.
